Burns Injury

Introduction

Your child has sustained a burn. Superficial burns to the limbs or body will be dressed with a non-adherent and layers of other dressing. Please keep these dry and clean.

We often take a photograph of the burn to send to the Specialist Burns Unit for advice. If necessary, your child may be sent to the Burns Unit at Queen Victoria Hospital for review.

If necessary give your child pain relief such as Calpol or Ibuprofen. Please ensure you read and follow the dosage instructions on the bottle or packet carefully. It is helpful to give the child pain relief before they come for their review, as it can be uncomfortable having the dressing removed.

The burn dressing should remain undisturbed until your child's appointment at the Burns Clinic in the Paediatric Accident and Emergency Department unless:-

- Fluid seeps through the dressing
- It becomes accidentally wet
- Your child experiences increasing discomfort after initial improvement.
- Your child feels ill and/or develops a temperature.
- Blisters develop in areas where there was previously just reddening

Should any of the above take place, take your child back to the Paediatric Accident and Emergency Department.
